Notes:	Second Lieutenant Sherman was a member of the 6135th Maintenance and Supply Squadron, 6122nd Air Base Group. He was the "kicker" of a C-119B "Flying Boxcar" transport with the 61st Troop Carrier Squadron, 314th Troop Carrier Group. On June 3, 1951, his aircraft was struck with debris from another C-119 that had been hit by enemy fire. It crashed about three miles from Inje, killing him and five crew members. Second Lieutenant Sherman was awarded the Purple Heart, the Korean Service Medal, the United Nations Service Medal, the National Defense Service Medal and the Republic of Korea War Service Medal.
